VCTC Practical Nursing Scholarship Information/Instructions

Applicants will be considered for tuition assistance through the application process. These scholarships are for students that do not have more than 50% of their tuition/books and fees paid by their employer or other program/grant/entity. This does not include private loans that you are required to pay back. If you are an incoming student and you have made arrangements to participate in the payment plan through the school, please keep in mind that these scholarships are not intended to cover the first or second installments due under the terms of the agreement. The scholarship will be applied to the third installment due in November.

- Due date for incoming 1st year students is September 30.
- Due date for rising 2nd year students is April 30.
- All applications must be complete and turned in to the Practical Nursing Coordinator by the due date in order to be considered for the scholarship.

First year students will qualify for an amount up or equal to 1/3 of the total tuition and fees for the current school year. If the recipient of the scholarship is participating in a payment plan arranged through VCTC, the funds will be applied to their account balance. If the recipient has a zero-account balance due, the funds will be issued to the recipient in the form of a check. There may be up to 2 recipients.

Example: *2020 tuition/books and fees for a first year, in region PN student:

Tuition/Books = 4200.00 & Fees = 783.00 for a total of 4983.00 divided into 3 installments = <u>a total award of 1661.00</u>

Second year students will qualify for the <u>total tuition/books portion of the amount due</u>. Students will continue to be responsible for associated fees. Due date for scholarship applications for second year students is April 30 of current school year. Awards funds will be applied directly to student account and remaining fees due will need to be paid by July 15. Up to 1 recipient.

Example: *2020 tuition/books and fees for a second year, in region student:

Tuition/Books = 4000.00 and Fees = 475.00 = a total award of 4000.00

Applicants will be considered based upon financial need, academic standing, overall professionalism demonstrated by attendance and overall contributions in class such as consistent respectful interactions with faculty and classmates.
