



Below you will find a list of tuition resources for you to explore. These resources change as scholarship money becomes available or is used. Please keep in mind that community grants and programs are variable from year to year and that not all students will qualify for all programs due to differing individual circumstances.

VCTC PN Tuition and Fees Payment Plan- A payment plan established for the 2020-2021 school year is for 1st year students that are not receiving more than 50% of their tuition and fees paid for by a third party. In order to participate, you must make arrangements with Darla Miller (VCTC principal) by July 1 of the current school year. If installment payments are not made by the date due, the student will not be allowed to continue in the program. The total amount of tuition and fees due will be divided into 3 equal installments and will be due as follows:
First installment = by July 15
Second installment = by September 15
Third installment = by November 15

VCTC- Practical Nursing Program Scholarships- Applicants will be considered for tuition assistance through an application process. This is for students that do not have more than 50% of their tuition and fees paid by their employer or other program/grant/entity and will not cover the first or second installment/payment of the program if you have made arrangements to participate in the payment plan. Scholarships are awarded in October of each year for 1st year students and in June for 2nd year students. *See scholarship application for more details

Valley Workforce- Offers financial assistance for tuition, fees and miscellaneous school expenses for those that meet qualifications. Financial support is available for qualified applicants on a 1st come, 1st served basis. Valley Workforce is not affiliated in any way with VCTC.
